Faith ALONE!

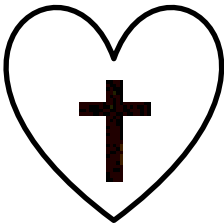
Grace ALONE!

Color the parts of the seal as you learn about Martin Luther's reasons for each part.



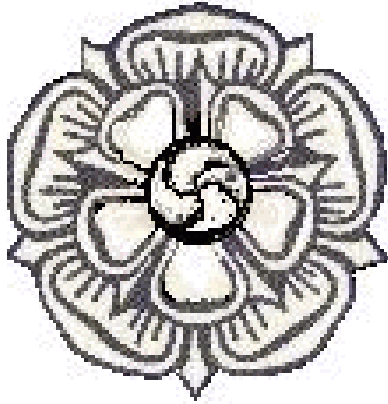
Black Cross

Red Heart

We live because Jesus shed His blood for us.

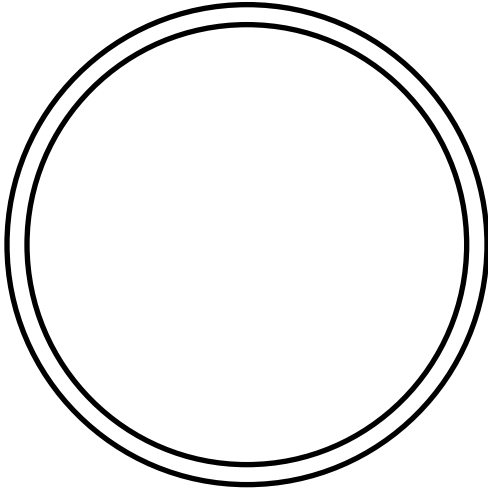
Our faith in Him has saved us.



White Rose

Blue Background

Reminds us that we will meet Jesus in heaven.

Gold Circle

Gold is precious; it reminds us of heaven's endless joys.
